The project's main objectives are to upgrade their teaching staff and improve some of the teaching facilities (library and other relevant equipment) at the faculties.</p> <p>Specific objectives are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to upgrade 20 members of the staff of the two faculties to the level of LL.M / M.A. with a professional research interest - the revision of the curriculum and its elements at a level of greater transparency in terms of its educational goals and how these relate to actual course contents; and subsequently implementation of the revised curriculum at an improved level of competence - upgrade the (library) facilities and other supportive facilities within the limits imposed by the project's budget, in particular to have a basic library collection for purposes of teaching and a minimum collection adequate to an undergraduate law school 						<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - consultancy services - inception mission - one evaluation mission
