<p>The <b>overall objective</b> of this project was to strengthening the capacity of the Turkish judiciary in the area of in-service training through the transfer of knowledge and know-how of EU-law. Based on a training needs' analysis and in close consulting with the representatives of the Directorate EU Affairs of the Turkish Ministry of Justice, the following issues were selected to be addressed in the framework of the project:</p> <p>The <b>achieved results</b> are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Development of courses on selected topics of EU law</b> The courses focused on the following topics: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Introduction to European Institutions &amp; to European law;</li> <li>2. Matters of European Criminal Justice;</li> <li>3. Administrative Law in EU perspective;</li> <li>4. Competition law in European perspective.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Training of trainers in the selected fields of EU law</b> A group of 25 Turkish experts was selected and trained in the selected fields of EU law. Next to the training seminars that were conducted in Turkey by Turkish and Dutch trainers, the future trainers visited the Netherlands and got acquainted with the daily practice of Dutch experts in upholding EU law. Besides, they visited the Academy of European Law in Germany and got a more in-depth training on some agreed aspects of the developed courses.</li> <li>• <b>Try-out seminars</b> At the end of their training, the future Turkish trainers conducted 4 try-outs. One Dutch expert was present as a resource person at each of those seminars.</li> <li>• <b>Dissemination of information</b> The project used the Website of the Ministry of Justice for disseminating the various developed courses and materials.
