In order to achieve this outcome 4 project outputs have been formulated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Capacities of national and local government to act, commit and deliver on public security and protecting human rights are increased by taking responsibilities for one's role and applying principles of good governance and rule of law;</li> <li>• Capacities of national and local government to achieve coherence and to adapt frameworks for policy development are increased by setting quality performance standards on public security in line with European standards;</li> <li>• Capacities of national and local government to relate to external stakeholders are increased and demonstrated by participation of civil society, in particular minority groups, in decision-making process, protection of minority rights and promotion of a culture of tolerance and anti-discrimination;</li> <li>• Capacities of training institutes to achieve coherence are increased by providing training in the field of good governance, rule of law, public security and human rights.</li> </ul> <p>All foreseen and undertaken activities are of capacity building nature and aim to strengthen the democratic leadership and capacity of (semi-) governmental institutions to ensure public security and further integration of reforms processes to align with European standards.
