The Rule of Law Facility provides support for activities within the framework of the justice system reform programs of the countries mentioned above. Special attention will be given to activities which are not part of big donor-programs, but that make a valuable contribution tot the justice reform program and /or are in need of prompt and short-term financing. The initial idea was to support the six countries by means of missions, small projects, study visits, seminars and one big project in Yemen. However, requests from the beneficiary countries were not so focused on study visits or seminars, but more on medium-sized projects with input of Dutch experts. Instead of a number of small activities in 5 countries and one big project in Yemen, the support has resulted in a number of medium to big sized projects in China, Indonesia, Mali and Yemen and some small sized activities in all the countries.
