<p>The overall objective of this project is to contribute to the enhancement of the Rule of Law by strengthening the skills and competencies of the judiciary and the public prosecution office of the Republic of Indonesia. Based on the actual needs and the added value that can be brought by the Netherlands institutions, the project is specified in three different components with the following purposes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ To enhance competencies of the Indonesian judges and prosecutors through judicial training and applied research;</li> <li>▪ To strengthen the Mahkamah Agung as the supreme judicial instance by strengthening chamber system and the development of a model for cassation limitation;</li> <li>▪ To develop a rational model and concepts for a modern court administration system in Indonesia, in particular with regard to performance-based court budgeting.</li> </ul> <p>The support is built upon the ongoing cooperation between the partner institutions and it is intended to follow-up the results of the former cooperation, such as the improvement in organizing a judicial training program (the Indonesian Judicial Training Centre has adopted a curriculum for its candidate judge training program that was learnt from the practice in the Netherlands), the improvement of the chamber system (the chamber system has been implemented in Indonesia after consultation with, among other, the Dutch Supreme Court), and the study on the performance-based court budgeting (the Indonesian Judicial Commission is inspired by the practice in the Netherlands).</p> <p>Our vision for this project is to contribute to the improved capacity of the judicial institutions in Indonesia by providing relevant skills and knowledge from the Netherlands. Such a capacity will be needed in order to uphold legal certainty and, as subsequently, to provide a better legal protection to justice seekers.
