Detailed description of project						Type and scope of services provided		
<p>During three years (2012-2014), CILC and the Academy for Legislation designed and implemented the Matra South Training Programme Legislation. The aim of the programme was to train legal experts from Egypt, Jordan, Libya, Morocco and Tunisia in the field of legislation. In the framework of this training programme, the participants were introduced to all aspects of the Dutch legislative process. They received training in applying tools, used by legislative drafters in the Netherlands and the European Union.</p> <p>The overall objective of the training was to support the democratic changes and a sustainable transition in the Arab region towards upholding the rule of law and respect for human rights. The specific objectives of the training were as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Train a group of twenty-five civil servants per year (experts and policy-makers) in the field of legislative drafting; • Acquaint the participants from the Arab countries with the Dutch system and the best practices of the Netherlands and Europe in the field of legislative drafting; • Enhance networking and cooperation between the Dutch experts and their Arab colleagues; • Provide practical information and advises to the Arab participants to help solve a number of issues that are being debated in their countries; • Enhance networking and the exchange of expertise and information amongst the participants of the various Arab countries. <p>A total group of sixty-six (66) civil servants representing Egypt, Jordan, Libya, Morocco, and Tunisia attended the Matra South training Programme Legislation 2012-2014. The training was provided in two legs i.e. Part I took place in the Netherlands while Part II was held in the region.</p> <p>The Matra-South Training Programme has been developed by the Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs and is implemented by the Netherlands Enterprise Agency (Ministry of Economic Affairs).</p>						<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Organise a three-week training course (of which two weeks in the Netherlands and 1 week in the region) for a group of twenty-five civil servants in the field of legislative drafting. - Enhance networking and cooperation - Provide practical information and advice which are relevant to the countries' needs and which can help in solving issues in the field of legislative drafting that are being debated <p>CILC provided 25 Dutch legislation experts (23 days), 1 Netherlands Debate Institute expert (1 day) 9 local legislation experts (18 days) and 1 course moderator (39 days).</p> <p>CILC staff consisted of 2: project manager (62 days), project officer (52 days).</p>
