<p>This project has been jointly developed by CILC and the Dutch Council for Refugees (DCR) and the Dutch Immigration and Naturalisation Service (IND). It focuses on the Bosnian asylum and migration chain and targets the Bosnian Ministry of Security (MoS), the Service for Foreigners Affairs, the Border Police, and Vasa Prava. The overall objective of this project is to enhance the effective management of asylum and migration in Bosnia and Herzegovina.</p> <p>The intended ultimate impact of the project is to increase access to a fair and efficient asylum procedure for asylum seekers and to enhance the treatment of illegal and legal migrants in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The project proposes an all encompassing strategy targeting the various actors within the migration chain, both separately and jointly.</p> <p>The project has 2 components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Strengthening the capacities of the migration authorities of Bosnia and Herzegovina ▪ Enhancement of the capacities of NGOs in the field of asylum and migration and enhancement of the cooperation between the migration authorities and the NGOs <p>The result areas of the intervention are the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The process of admission, the identification of vulnerable groups and illegal migrants, and the referral of asylum seekers and illegal migrants to specialized counselling; - The implementation in practice of relevant EU Directives in the field of asylum and migration; - Assisting the drafting of new legislation and regulations on asylum and migration; - Improving the cooperation between all partners in the BiH asylum and migration chain; - The understanding of the role and position in the asylum chain of the migration authorities and active NGOs; <p>Main activities in the project are trainings and workshops, seminars, advisory meetings and working meetings, on the job coaching and a study visit to the Netherlands. Dutch expertise is provided by Involved Dutch public institutions - Immigration and Naturalisation Service (IND), Repatriation and Departure Service (DT&V), Central Agency for the Reception of Asylum Seekers (COA).
