<p>The project responds to the request of Kigali International Arbitration Centre (KIAC) to enhance its capacity in Arbitration services in Rwanda. KIAC, established in 2012 aims to become a regional Arbitration Centre and to be a forum of arbitration for parties who are not willing to submit their cases to the existing formal court proceedings. KIAC delivers the following services to local and international clients:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Management of arbitration according to KIAC's own rules and the rules of UNCITRAL; • Promotion of the pro-arbitration policy of the Rwandan legal system, whereby arbitration related cases are prioritised and dealt with in a timely manner; • Provision on request of administrative and technical support of parties in ad hoc arbitration; • Provision of legal advice during the preparation of international commercial and investment contracts; <p>The main objective of the project is to strengthen the accessibility and quality of the ADR system in Rwanda. The specific objectives are of three folds:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Strengthened capacity of KIAC to coordinate the development of ADR; 2. Enhanced service provision of (legal) professionals in the ADR domain; 3.
