<p>In this new project, CILC seeks to strengthen the connection between the judiciary and society in Ukraine through targeted capacity building support delivered by experts from the Dutch judiciary. The related long-term objective is increased public trust of Ukrainian citizens in a strengthened independent, impartial, transparent and predictable judiciary. The project focuses on improving judicial governance, promoting self-government of judges and increasing the professionalism of judges and staff in up to 7 target courts in the Kyiv region. The project team will work on two components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Work on guidelines for court proceedings - Work on procedural justice and core values of the judiciary <p>The project will deploy a Project Leader semi-permanently to Kyiv to ensure smooth implementation, as well as regular and swift contact with the operational beneficiaries and institutional partners.
