Detailed description of project				Type and scope of services provided				
<p>The OKP TMT+ New Narratives in Corrections and Alternative Sanctions is a capacity building project. The aim is to support innovations in the correctional service in Indonesia by introducing reforms and strengthen their capacity to manage offenders whilst in detention and outside. The TMT+ will contribute to Indonesian efforts to introduce alternative sanctions in criminal justice. Aside from capacity building, the project aims to reduce institutional gaps and strengthen coordination with correction service departments. Currently, there is little awareness of what probation work is and what the benefits are for the different partners in the criminal justice chain. Probation service is limited to supervision of offenders whilst in detention. This forms a barrier to introduce new measures like alternative sanctions that could help to reduce the prison population. More awareness and understanding are needed to ensure that the coordination between the different departments / organisations will improve and that the benefits of probation work can spill-over to these departments. The TMT+ outputs are built around three training interventions.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Support and collaborate with project Dutch and local project experts to strengthen the initial training programme for probation and prison staff</li> <li>2. Provide a mutual working space for knowledge exchange between the NL and Indonesia on policy and regulation reform.</li> <li>3.
